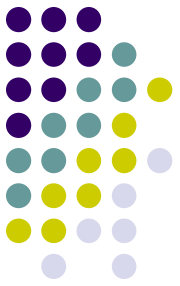
The value of Arts and Humanities

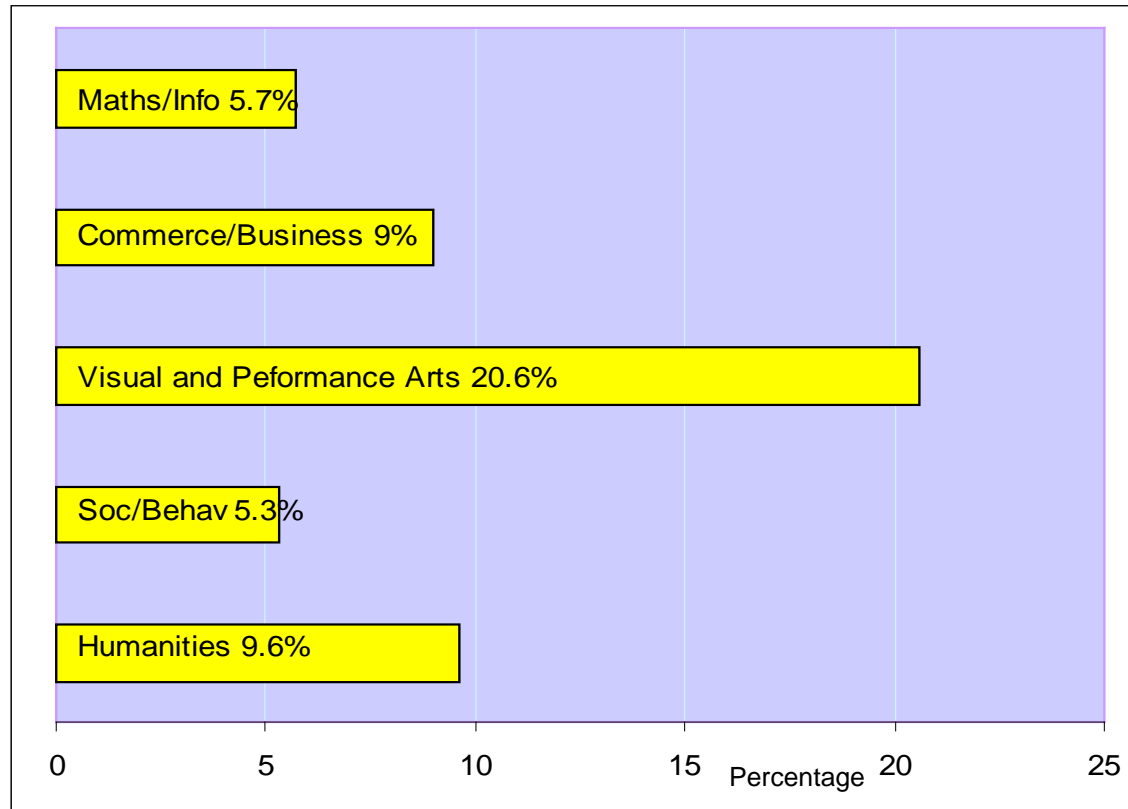
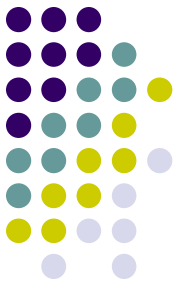


What kind of graduates are employed in business?

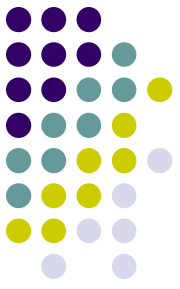
