

# MRGS YEAR 9, 10 & 11 UNIFORM: 2012

The only official supplier of the school uniform is the MRGS Uniform Shop: Somerset Road, Mt Roskill.

<b>GIRLS</b>	<b>Skirt</b>	One of the two regulation styles Either: (a) Regulation polyester/wool, navy mid calf length skirt. (b) Regulation polyester/wool, navy full length skirt.
Or:	<b>Trousers:</b>	Regulation navy girls boot legged
	<b>Jersey:</b>	Regulation navy jersey with school crest.
	<b>Blouse:</b>	Regulation MRGS blouse with coloured school logo on pocket; long or mid-sleeved (navy collar, trim and buttons)
	<b>Singlet:</b> (Optional)	A plain white scooped or V-neck singlet which is not visible below the school blouse. <i>Worn under the blouse and tucked in. No long-sleeved garment may be worn under a short-sleeved blouse. Must not be visible at the neck.</i>
	<b>Shoes:</b>	Black leather, flat-heeled, full-foot, lace-up school shoes with backs. The shoes must be able to be polished. <i>No high heeled, patent leather, canvas, suede leather, high-soled (platform), ballet-type, backless shoes, boots, sandals, scuffs, jandals, slippers, track shoes or casual street brand shoes such as Nike, Chuck Taylors or Vans may be worn.</i>
	<b>Socks/ Tights:</b>	White MRGS regulation ankle socks or black pantyhose.
	<b>Jacket:</b>	Regulation MRGS jacket. <i>Only the regulation MRGS jacket may be worn during, to and from the school. A raincoat may also be worn to and from the school during wet weather.</i>
	<b>PE Shirt:</b>	Regulation MRGS shirt
	<b>PE Shorts:</b>	Regulation MRGS shorts

<b>BOYS</b>	<b>Shorts:</b>	Regulation polyester/wool, navy shorts.

Or:	<b>Trousers:</b>	Regulation polyester/wool, navy dress trousers.
	<b>Jersey:</b>	Regulation navy jersey with school crest.
	<b>Shirt:</b>	Regulation MRGS open-necked shirt with coloured school logo on pocket; long or short-sleeved (navy collar, trim and buttons).
	<b>Singlet:</b> (Optional)	A plain scooped or V-necked singlet which is not visible beneath the school shirt <i>Worn under the shirt and tucked in. No long-sleeved garment may be worn under a short-sleeved shirt. Must not be visible at the neck.</i>
	<b>Shoes:</b>	Black leather, flat-heeled, lace-up, full-foot school shoes with backs. The shoes must be able to be polished. <i>No high heeled, patent leather, canvas, suede leather, high-soled (platform), ballet-type, backless shoes, boots, sandals, scuffs, jandals, slippers, track shoes or casual street brand shoes such as Nike, Chuck Taylors or Vans may be worn.</i>
	<b>Socks:</b>	MRGS regulation knee high socks worn with shorts, black dress socks with trousers.
	<b>Jacket:</b>	Regulation MRGS jacket. <i>Only the regulation MRGS jacket may be worn during, to and from the school. A raincoat may also be worn to and from the school during wet weather.</i>
	<b>PE Shirt:</b>	Regulation MRGS shirt
	<b>PE Shorts:</b>	Regulation MRGS shorts

**ALL ITEMS EXCEPT SHOES ARE AVAILABLE ONLY FROM MRGS UNIFORM SHOP**

**All non-uniform items that are worn may be confiscated.**

**Students flouting the uniform regulations may be sent home.**

**All items of uniform including bags and caps are to be kept graffiti and tag free.**

**No items of clothing with external brand names (excluding an MRGS label) may be worn.**

**Name items of clothing and equipment clearly.**

**No modification to the length of the uniform skirt is allowed.**

*If a student is not a stock size, uniform items can be made to measure. Made-to-measure items incur an additional cost of \$10 per item for any order placed after December 2011.*
