As you are aware the Government has announced that the Auckland region is moving to **Alert Level 3** as of midday tomorrow (Wednesday August 12). We will remain at Alert Level 3 for three days, until midnight Friday 14 August. Further information will be available from Wednesday August 12.

- The overriding principle for Alert Level 3 is stay home wherever possible.
- The majority of students at all year levels will remain at home.
- Only students who have parents or caregivers who are essential workers and require their child to come to school will attend. These students will be allocated a classroom for the duration of Alert Level 3. We will implement the Level 3 practices of hand sanitising, disinfecting surfaces, and physical distancing immediately.
- If you are an essential worker and require your child to attend school for August 12-14 please let us know by replying to this email.

Wednesday 12 August will be a Teacher Only Day.

- Many students will be able to continue with learning already underway.
- No teacher led distance learning will happen tomorrow, Wednesday August 12.
- Some of our senior students may be concerned about assessments. Any assessments due this week are on hold until further notice.

We have done this well in the past and we have every confidence in our school community working together to keep learning and stay healthy. As soon as we have any further information we will be in contact with you to update you.
